I. Call to Order

The November Supervisory Committee meeting was called to order by Pieter Van Ry, SPR Director. Director Van Ry welcomed everyone to the Microsoft Teams conference call.





II. Consideration of Minutes for Previous Supervisory Committee Meetings No action was taken on previous minutes.

III. Action Item(s)

Beneficial Use Truck Leasing Agreement

Caroline Miller, SPR Asset Manager, presented the Committee with a recommendation to approve a Beneficial Use Truck Leasing Agreement (Lease) with McCandless Truck Center, in the amount of \$119.232.

SPR recommends leasing three (3) trucks, which are needed to haul biosolids to the SPR-owned farm in eastern Colorado. SPR currently owns four (4) trucks that have reached the end of their useful life and have experienced maintenance issues.

SPR published a request for proposal on the Rocky Mountain E-Purchasing System and received two (2) proposals. SPR selected McCandless for the Lease, who demonstrated a complete understanding of the scope of work and met all required specifications. The Lease is for a one (1) year term, with the option for four (4) additional one-year rentals. A comprehensive maintenance package is included in McCandless' proposal, which will ensure the trucks remain in service.

<u>ACTION TAKEN</u> – The Supervisory Committee considered the recommendation to approve the award of a Beneficial Use Truck Leasing Agreement to McCandless Truck Center, in the amount of \$119,232.

Committee Member D'Andrea moved to approve the recommendation, Committee Member Relph seconded the motion, four ayes, and zero nays. Motion approved.

IV. Informational Items

SPR staff discussed these informational items with the Committee:

- Director's Update
 - Blair Corning, SPR Deputy Director Environmental Programs, discussed several site security initiatives at SPR, as well as recent pretreatment program enforcement actions.
 - Jamie Safulko, Interim Deputy Director Engineering, provided an update on the asset management program. SPR held workshops with WSP, SPR's asset management consultant, to develop a scope of work for enhancing the facility's enterprise asset management software.
 - Brian Tracy, Deputy Director Operations & Maintenance, reported the results of the CIRSA audit completed in October. SPR received no violations.





- SPR Influent Flow and Load Summary
 - The measured flow to SPR averaged 16.4 mgd in October 2021, which is a decrease of approximately 0.1 mgd from October 2020. The measured flow split was 45.7 / 54.3 percent between the cities of Littleton and Englewood.
- Fiscal Management and Reporting
 - Director Van Ry presented the financial report and aggregate purchases report for September and October 2021.
